Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

Bishop Folda has given permission for a new sound system at Little Flower. The parish council has been working with Dakota Sound Systems of Bismarck, ND for the last couple of months. Dakota Sound Systems have been very helpful in guarding the cost of the project by stopping in Rugby on their way with business in Belcourt.

Dakota Sound Systems have done an analysis of the interior of the church with recommendations that will greatly improve the sound system in the church. The project "includes 2 sets of line-array speakers which will be mounted on the columns on either side of the sanctuary steps. The line-array design is to help control the ambient nature of the space in order to increase speech intelligibility. Four hanging speakers will cover the front side seating areas and the balcony. One digital wall control will be installed for adjustment of volumes of all inputs. One wireless system with countryman earset is included for the pastor's microphone".

The speakers will no longer be on the ceiling but lowered to the sides for better hearing, which will greatly improve the sound in the church. The cost of the project is \$30,695.00. Contributions for this project would be greatly appreciated. Thank you very much in advance.


