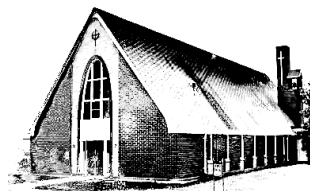

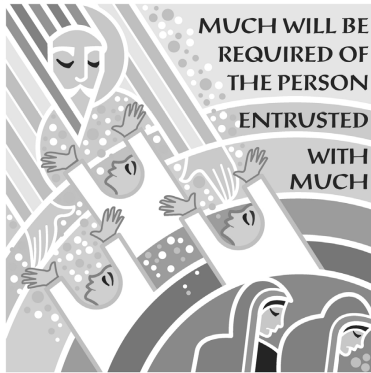

**Redeemed Eucharistic Conference.** *“My flesh for the life of the World.”* - John 6:51. The Catholic Church teaches: “what Jesus did for the salvation of humanity is made present in the celebration of the Eucharist, including his sacrificial Death and Resurrection. Christ’s sacrifice of himself to the Father was efficacious and salvific because of the supreme love with which he shed his blood, the price of our salvation, and offered himself to the Father on our behalf. His blood, shed for us, is the eternal sign of that love. As a memorial, the Eucharist is not another sacrifice, but the re-presentation of the sacrifice of Christ by which we are reconciled to the Father.” As part of the **Eucharistic Revival**, the Diocese of Fargo will host a Redeemed Eucharistic Conference in Fargo, September 23-24, 2022. Among the speakers will be Bishop John Folda, Bishop Andrew Cozzens of the Diocese of Crookston, MN, who is heading up the National Eucharistic Revival for the USCCB, Monsignor James Shea, President of the University of Mary in Bismarck, and other dignitaries and Eucharistic scholars.
