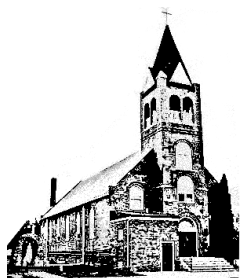

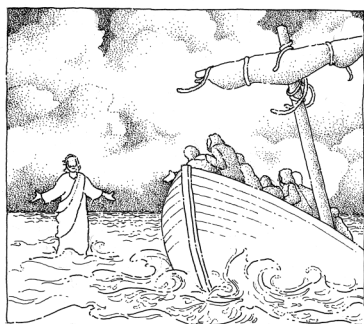
New Parishioners
