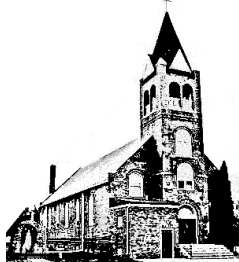

Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

"A voice of one crying out in the desert: prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths" (Mk 1:3). The Gospel of the second Sunday of Advent reminds us of our need to be open to the message of Christmas, which is often forgotten in the midst of all the lights and glitter. Our Blessed Lord desires to share his life with each of us so that we may become an instrument of his saving grace for those whom we share our life with every day. Let each of us prepare for his coming, which is soon to be!

"We know that there are three comings of the Lord. The third lies between the other two. It is invisible, while the other two are visible. In the first coming he was seen on earth, dwelling among men; he himself testifies that they saw him and hated him. In the final coming all flesh will see the salvation of our God, and they will look on him whom they pierced. The intermediate coming is a hidden one; in it only the elect see the Lord within their own selves, and they are saved. In his first coming our Lord came in our flesh and in our weakness; in this middle coming he comes in spirit and in power; in the final coming he will be seen in glory and majesty. Because this coming lies between the other two, it is like a road on which we travel from the first coming to the last. In the first, Christ was our redemption; in the last, he will appear as our life; in this middle coming, he is our rest and consolation" (From a sermon by St. Bernard, Abbot).
