Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

The Season of Advent begins today. It is the shortest Advent possible, with only three full weeks. The Advent Season is important for the preparation for the celebration of the birth of our Savor, Jesus Christ.

"When the Church celebrates the liturgy of Advent each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for his second coming. By celebrating the precursor's birth and martyrdom, the Church unites herself to his desire: 'He must increase, but I must decrease'" (CCC, 524).

This Sunday is also the beginning of Year B in the three-year cycle of the lectionary for Sunday. The weekday cycle has a two-year cycle, and this year is cycle II. St. Mark is the primary evangelist for the Year B.

Mark's gospel was written in Greek, primarily for Gentile Christians, because he uses terms, which were meaningless for non-believers. It is the shortest gospel written in Rome with a blend of history and theology in simple terms. The date of composition is around 70 A.D.
