SPOTLIGHT ON MINISTRY KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS



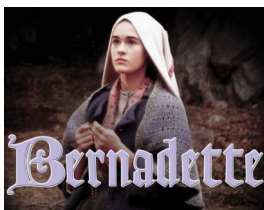

As a couple, Louis and Zélie reached the ultimate goal of matrimony which is sanctity for their spouse and holiness for their children. Together they raised five daughters who followed God's call to religious vocations. Louis and Zélie Martin are the parents of St. Therese the Little Flower and are known as the Patron Saints of the Domestic Church. Their family motto was *"Serve God First, Together."*
