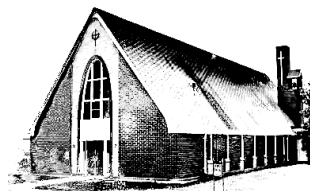

Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and St. Mary's,

We welcome the NET Ministries Team from the Archdiocese of St. Paul-Minneapolis to our parishes this weekend. The team is here to provide a retreat experience to our youth in grades 7-12. "NET retreats are designed to present youth with the truth of who they are as God's children and how true joy and meaning of life are found by accepting Christ's gift of salvation and living as His disciple". The NET team consists of young Catholics aged 18-28 who "leave behind their jobs, school, family and friends to devote nine months" of service to the Church. We thank them very much.

Next Sunday evening at Little Flower there will be a Knights of Columbus Pilgrim Icon Program at 7:00 pm in the church. It is a prayer service in honor of St. Joseph. It will consist of readings from Sacred Scripture, the Rosary, and the Litany of St. Joseph. Everyone is welcome to come and pray.

Last Sunday after the 8:00 am Mass a host, the Eucharist, was found on the floor wrapped in tissue paper near the entrance of the Little Flower Church. This is a very serious matter. "Sacilege is a grave sin especially when committed against the Eucharist, for in this sacrament the true Body of Christ is made substantially present for us" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 2120). It is very important that the Eucharist be consumed immediately upon reception. The Eucharist cannot be carried outside the church to be given to someone else without special permission of the pastor.

"Anyone aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of penance" (*CCC*, 1415). Any person at Mass not in a proper state to receive the Eucharist, when coming up to receive Communion, should cross their arms on their chest to indicate they are not able to receive. No one needs to know why a person did not receive Communion. There are many reasons a person may be unable to receive Holy Communion.

There will be a special Holy Hour in reparation, the act of making amends, at Little Flower on January 30th at 7:00 pm. Everyone is welcome.

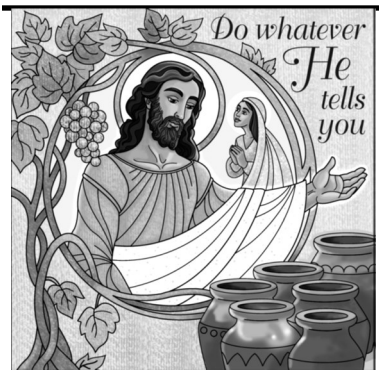
New Parishioners
