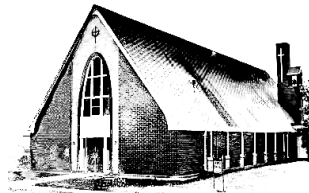

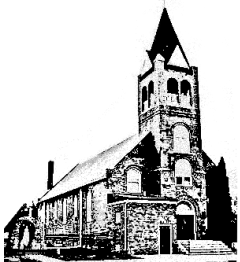

Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink" (Jn 6:53-55).

The display of Eucharistic Miracles in the church is the work of Blessed Carlo Acutis who passed away in 2006. His feast day is October 12th.

"If we get in front of the sun, we get sun tans, but when we get in front of Jesus in the Eucharist, we become saints," the words of Blessed Carlo Acutis. He was born in England, but his parents move to Italy when he was a baby. At a very young age he was drawn to the Eucharist and every time he passed a church, he wanted to enter the church to greet Jesus. At the age of seven he made his first communion, and he became a daily Mass attendee.

God gave him a special grace to know that he would not live long, but that did not sadden him. He did not want to waste time, so he devoted himself to charitable works and served as a catechist.

He began traveling to places of Eucharistic miracles and he developed a website documenting the miracles. At the age of fifteen Carlo died of leukemia. "I am happy to die...because I have lived my life without wasting a minute on those things that do not please God.

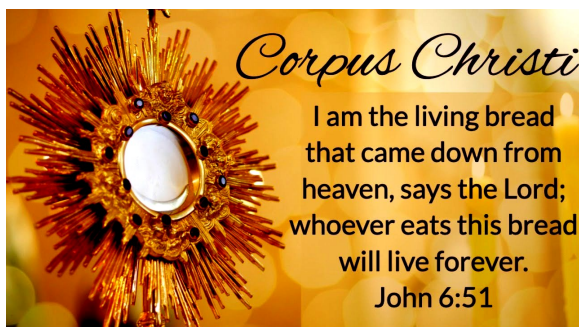
