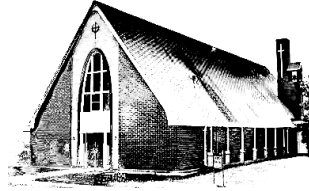

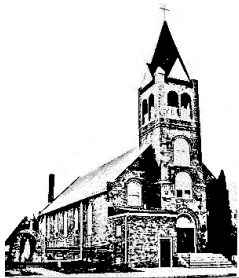

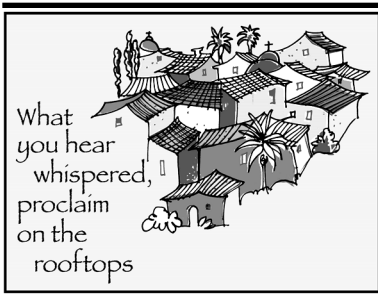
Parish ministers bring the Holy Eucharist to the homebound and the hospitalized. Please call the parish office to arrange for visitation.

In the Gospel today, we hear Jesus say: "Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father." **The St. Therese the Little Flower Conference of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul will continue their group study, Lectio; Evangelization on June 25 at 7:00 PM on the second floor of Little Flower School. Everyone is welcome; you do not need to be a member to participate in our group studies.**

The Confirmation and First Communion review and practice meeting has been changed to 9:00 - 10:15 AM on June 28 in the MCDR. Because no COVID-19 social distancing protocol changes are anticipated by June 28 we will not be able to go with our original plan for a group lunch to be served at noon. Our meeting for review and practice will happen with no meal and will be held at 9:00 AM between the 8:00 AM Mass and the 10:30 AM Mass. We encourage your family to attend Mass before or after the meeting. Also, encourage your child to receive the sacrament of reconciliation prior to July 2. There will be an opportunity for reconciliation for 3rd grade students following the 10:30 Mass.

Celebration of Confirmation and First Communion Mass will be on July 2 at 6:00 PM. Due to continued social distancing we will not have an opening procession with the children and their sponsors. Instead families will be assigned pews and we will have "Sponsor and Child" sit in their family pew. They will be seated nearest to the center aisle. All will be seated for the rosary prior to Mass. We will know more about the sitting arrangements for Mass by the June 28th meeting. At that meeting we will be able to let families know if we will have further seating capacity and the ability to have the anticipated reception following the Mass. Thank you for your patience with these changes. Please make a point to pick up your child's workbooks from the lunch room if you haven't already done so.

Little Flower will be discontinuing the 50-cents a Day Program. Dollars that were donated will be disbursed amongst statewide and local charities. Any future contributions to 50-cents a Day will be given to the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul. Thank you to all who have supported this program.

The faithful are dispensed from the Sunday obligation. This is for the benefit of those who are sick, and those who are more vulnerable to the disease (the elderly and those with underlying health conditions). It may also be the case that with the distancing measures in place and the resulting smaller capacity

of the church that not every parishioner will be able to attend Mass every Sunday. Daily Mass attendance is encouraged especially when the church is too full on Sunday.

Fr. Frank and Fr. Anthony continue to hear confessions Saturday mornings from 9:00 - 10:30. One will be in their car in the east parking lot and the other will be in the church. If you come into the church, there should only be one person in the church at a time. They are not permitted to use the confessional, so they will be set up in front of the altar.
