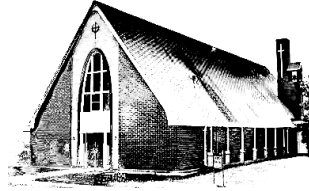

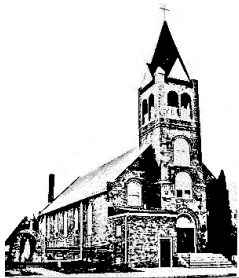

Dear members of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

Congratulations to the youths of the parishes who are finally able, after waiting for three months due to the pandemic, to make their First Communion and receive the Gifts of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation. We will welcome and we thank Bishop Folda for coming to Rugby for our youth. The Mass for Confirmation/ First Eucharist will be on Thursday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6:00 pm.

The residents of the Haaland Home were able to have Mass for the first time in three months on Thursday, June 25th. There are still strict procedures in place to get into the home and only the priest is allowed in for Mass. Hopefully, that will change soon. It was notable to find the ribbons in the Roman Missal – the book used on the altar - still on the second week of Lent where we had left off three months previously. The pandemic has challenged us to do things differently and I am not sure when we will get back to “normal.”

We are in the process of installing video equipment, thanks to the Knights of Columbus, to stream ceremonies taking place in the church. We hope everything will be ready for Confirmation on Thursday. However, getting equipment out of China is difficult right now.
