# Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is June 16th, followed by the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Pope Francis, in a homily on the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, said, "It is more difficult to let God love us than to love Him! The best way to love Him in return is to open our hearts and let Him love us."

Please welcome Seth Skjervheim, who was ordained to the diaconate at the Cathedral of St. Mary in Fargo on June 3<sup>rd</sup>. Deacon Seth will be with us for eight weeks. Deacon Seth's home parish is St. Alphonsus, in Langdon. He has one brother and one sister.

"Seth Skjervheim first wanted to be a priest when he was really young, around three or four years old. This spiritual growth continued through the year following the conference, and with it the call to the priesthood returned. Seth applied to seminary for the Diocese of Fargo in the spring semester of his senior year and began his formation at St. Gregory the Great Seminary in Seward, NE. He completed college seminary and is
