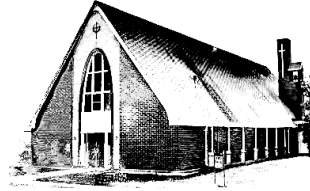

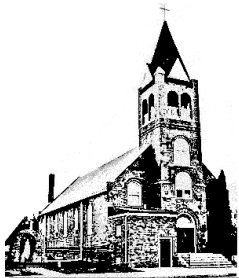

Message from our Pastor

Dear members of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Sacred Heart is God's visible sign of His love for us and we are called to live in that love. "Jesus knew and loved us each and all during his life, his agony and his Passion, and gave himself up for each one of us: The Son of God . . . loved me and gave himself for me. He has loved us all with a human heart. For this reason, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, pierced by our sins and for our salvation, is quite rightly considered the chief sign and symbol of that . . . love with which the divine Redeemer continually loves the eternal Father and all human beings without exception" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 478). The liturgical celebration of the Sacred Heart is June 19th, followed by the celebration of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on June 20th. "Mary's role in the Church is inseparable from her union with Christ and flows directly from it" (*CCC*, 964).

The landscaping on the east side of the church is almost complete. We are waiting on the downspouts. Special thanks to Sue Blessum and Linda Schneider for leading the project. Thanks to all who helped.

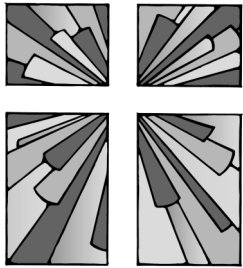
