It is an important day to remember the sacrifice made by so many women and men who have served in the Armed Forces, beginning with the sacrifice of many in the fight to establish our great county, a land of the free and the brave. Today, we celebrant Pentecost, the birthday of the Church, God's family on earth. The coming of the Holy Spirit was a great gift for the salvation of the world and a continuous gift of the Father's love for all his children.

They are at the service of charity which builds up the Church" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2003).
