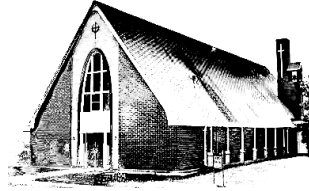

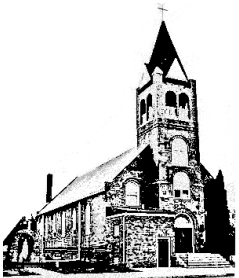

*Message from our Pastor*

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. As Christians, we know God as three persons in one, which we learned by the presence on earth of the Second Person of the Trinity. "The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the 'hierarchy of the truths of faith'. The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 234).

We hear in this Sunday's reading from the Gospel of St. Matthew the divine imperative of our blessed Lord to "Go." They did as the Lord asked and they went about proclaiming the "Good News." "The Paschal mystery of Christ's cross and Resurrection stands at the center of the Good News that the apostles, and the Church following them, are to proclaim to the world. God's saving plan was accomplished 'once for all' by the redemptive death of his Son Jesus Christ" (*CCC*, 571).

It would be a great blessing from God to have a few persons willing to serve as members of the Little Flower Cemetery Board. The board will meet about four times a year to discuss important matters pertaining to the cemetery. There are currently no board members.
