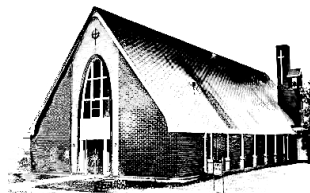

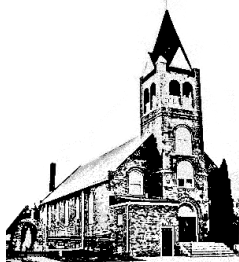

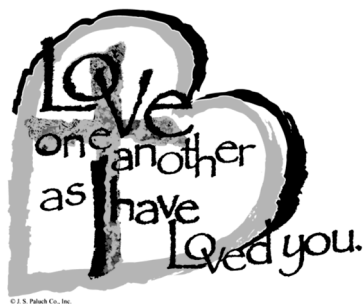
New Parishioners
