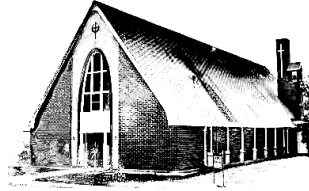

Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, St. Mary, and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel,

The month of November is especially noted for the remembrance of the faithful departed, especially the souls in purification, those in purgatory. St. Pope John Paul II (the Great) encouraged us to be mindful of the souls in purgatory, "We feel bound by charity to offer those brothers and sisters who have experienced the fragility proper to human existence the help of our vigilant prayer. May whatever residue of human weakness still remaining in them to delay their happy encounter with God be definitively wiped out" (St. Pope John Paul II, Address, 2 November 1982). "The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned. The Church formulated her doctrine of faith on Purgatory especially at the Councils of Florence and Trent. The tradition of the Church, by reference to certain texts of Scripture, speaks of a cleansing fire (Cf. 1 Cor 3:15; 1 Pt 1:7) (*Catholic Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1031)." The teaching on Purgatory "is also based on the practice of prayer for the dead, already mentioned in Sacred Scripture: "Therefore [Judah Maccabees] made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin" (2 Mac 12:46). From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God (Cf. Council of Lyons II (1274): DS 856. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead (CCC, 1032)."

Let us not forget to say "thank you" to our nations' veterans on Veterans Day, November 11th. It is an especially important day for all Americans and all peoples who desire freedom. It is a day to say thank you to those who risked their lives for our country and to commemorate those who died doing so. In addition, we pray daily for those who put their lives at risk so that we may enjoy every day; "life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness".

A special thank you to all who helped make Little Flower Curbside Fall Supper a great success. We had a lot more customers than we expected, and we are sorry for the many who were not able to purchase a meal. A special thank you to Glenda Mack and Denise Lagasse who were in-charge and organized it so well. It was a great meal of turkey and trimmings and 350 customers were served.

Special thanks to Monica Houim for organizing the Patriotic Rosary and all who participated. The event can be viewed on the YouTube channel, St. Therese the Little Flower, Rugby.

Always mindful of the deceased, but especially during November we pray; "May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace", Amen.
