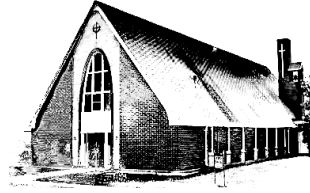

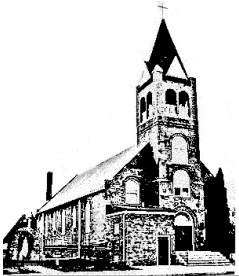

Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, St. Mary, and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel,

As disciples of Christ, most of us, are ever attentive of the need for a more profound relationship with the Trinity. The Trinity is always eager to assist us in our most important endeavors and to help us in our everyday activities. To facilitate God's assistance in our daily activities, it is necessary to pray individually, together in small groups or in a family gathering on a regular basis and to meditate frequently on scripture and the teachings of the Church. For the people of God, "prayer is the life of the new heart. It ought to animate us at every moment. But we tend to forget him who is our life and our all. This is why the Fathers of the spiritual life in the Deuteronomic and prophetic traditions insist that prayer is a remembrance of God often awakened by the memory of the heart 'We must remember God more often than we draw breath.' But we cannot pray 'at all times' if we do not pray at specific times, consciously willing it" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, para. 2697).

Unfortunately, COVID-19 cases continue to increase in the state of North Dakota. Therefore, we will have to continue to be diligent in the practice and knowledge of the procedures to keep everyone safe and well. We are thankful, so far, that the parishes and Little Flower School are doing well. Please pray that this will continue and that the menace of COVID-19 will come to an end soon. Let all of us strive to be mindful of the persons in our parish and community who are most vulnerable and unable to participate in the usual parish and community activities.

Please see the bulletin for the many parish opportunities to grow in the faith of Jesus Christ. As pastor, I am grateful for all who facilitate and help with various activities in the parishes. We are also grateful for this year's harvest and its completion in a timely manner. "We know that in everything God works for good with those who love him, who are called according to his purpose" (Rm 8:26).
