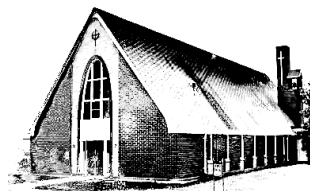

Everyone is invited to Little Flower cemetery on Tuesday, November 2 at 4:00 pm to pray the Rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet for all the faithful departed. "From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead: Let us help and commemorate them. If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice, why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1032).

All Saints Day this year is not a holy day of obligation. However, it is a good thing to attend Mass and ask the Saints to intercede for us. There is a great need for wisdom today to deal with the constant changes taking place in our society.

See the bulletin for Masses on All Souls Day. Let us meet together at Mass on All Souls Day to beg the Lord's blessing on our beloved dead relatives and friends in need of our prayers. They can not pray for themselves and so they are dependent upon the living to assist them.

“And ‘to love him with all your heart, with all your understanding, with all your strength, and to love your neighbor as yourself’ is worth more than all the burnt offerings and sacrifices.” (MARK 12:33)

Of all the gifts that God gives us, the one He wants the most is our heart. He wants us to share out of our love for Him, not out of obligation. Using our talent in parish ministry and contributing money to support our parish mission is important, but it is more important to spend time in prayer with God daily and discern how He is calling us to be generous with all of our gifts. The 2021 God's Gift Appeal is on-going until the end of this year.
